

2019 VBS Contests:

Daily Cool Contest

These are super-simple things that the kids will get points for each day. One child who participates will also be chosen to receive a prize every day.

Daily Challenges:

- Sunday: Gummy Bear Guessing Game: Guess how many gummy bears are in the jar.
- Monday: Dress-up Day: Dress up like you are going on a race.
- Tuesday: Missions Money Mania: Bring money for the missions offering and all of your points for the day are doubled!
- Wednesday: Bible Verse Challenge-Find three verses that have the words “love one another” in them. Write them down (or have someone write them down) and bring them with you.

How it Works:

- At the registration table (if the child participates in the contest), their name will be put into a bucket (except for Monday).
- At the closing assembly, Matt will name a winner of the daily challenge and that individual will get a prize. Winners will be determined by:
 - Sunday-the closest guess
 - Monday-the teens will pick the best dressed kid
 - Tuesday-all kids who bring missions money will put their name in a bucket and one name will be drawn to get a prize
 - Wednesday-kids who participate will put their name in a bucket and one name will be drawn to get a prize.
- At each closing assembly, Matt will also announce the challenge for the next day.

Individual Challenge

These are super-easy. At the end of every day, each child will have a piece of paper to take home. If they bring it back completed, it goes into a bucket (boys’ bucket and girls’ bucket) and at the closing program six people will be chosen from there to receive prizes.

Team Challenge

This is similar to the point system that we’ve had for previous years. However, instead of working for individual achievement goals; they will be working together as a team. Each of the three teams will be competing against each other to win a pizza party.

Every individual will earn points for attendance (1,000 points), participating in the cool contest (1,000 points), bringing a Bible (2,000 points), memorizing a verse (3,000 points), or bringing a friend (5,000 points). All of the points will be added up and divided by the number of kids there were in that class. Each day’s points for each team will be added up and the winning team will be announced on the parent’s night.

The pizza party will most likely take place at Pizza Hut the week after VBS. More details on that will be coming.
