Commonly Asked Questions:

1. How do I talk to my kids about this?

- Talk to them about the way people see things (worldview).
- Talk to them about the value of men and women and then about the differences between men and women.
- Dismantle some of the stereotypes of what a “man” is and what a “woman” is.

- Walk through Genesis 1-3 (Creation, Blueprint, Fall, Promise of Redemption)
- Remind them that not everybody accepts this view.
- Talk about gender dysphoria. “One of the ways that people are broken is that they feel as though they were born a different gender than how God made them.”
- Explain what it means to be a Christian. “We follow Jesus, no matter what, and we trust his plan and design even when it doesn’t make sense to us and especially when it is really hard.”
